

#### **Total Undergraduate Applications for Spring 2023: 3,919**

The Profile of New Academic Freshmen is based on the freshmen cohort model for enrolled students. The cohort captures first time, degree-seeking undergraduate students. Non-degree seeking, concurrent high school, bridge and second degree seeking students are excluded from the cohort. Application and admission numbers are based on admit type, not cohort. Application numbers include those from applicants who did not complete the application process and were not given an admission decision.






Figure 1- Age of Enrolled New Freshmen




Figure 2 – College Majors of Enrolled New Freshmen




Figure 3 – Credit Load for New Enrolled Freshmen
