TRIO Rising Scholars Program Peer Mentor Program:

The purpose of the Mentoring Program is to increase the academic and social success of first-year TRIO Rising Scholars Program (TRS) participants. The program continuing undergraduates in the program with first-year TRS students by creating a greater sense of community and involvement at Boise State University. Mentors build relationships with mentees by sharing their time and knowledge of campus resources to foster student engagement and confidence through these peer relationships.

Peer Mentor Responsibilities:

- Outreach to incoming TRIO students over the summer via email, phone & social media
- Attend Peer Mentor Orientation August 12 16, 2024: both on & off-campus
- Participate in Fall TRS Orientation on August 17 and TRS Spring Kickoff January, 2025
- Participate in a minimum of three scheduled TRS events per semester
- Position runs August 12, 2024 to May 2, 2025. Students can expect to work roughly eight (8) hours per week; more at beginning of the semester: Beginning salary is \$14/hr
- Attend weekly or bi-weekly meetings with TRS staff and peer mentors
- Provide TRS students with ongoing orientation to university and community life
- Meet with each mentee individually and in small group settings
- Offer academic success strategies and opportunities to students
- Encourage students to develop educational and career goals
- Introduce mentees to student engagement opportunities at TRS and on campus
- Create and facilitate promotional materials for TRS workshops
- Work together in pairs/team with co-mentors to contribute meaningfully to program

Peer Mentor General Requirements:

- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 (exceptions may be made after review)
- Excitement at the prospect of working with a diverse student population
- Completed a minimum of 24 credits at Boise State University
- Demonstrated student engagement at Boise State University
- Demonstrated excellent time management skills
- An open, engaging, empathetic personality
